“Assistant of a Nurse”

Specialty: 560001 – General Medicine (GM)

Total workload	5 credits (150 hours)
Objectives of Industrial Practice:	The objective of this industrial practice is to form and develop students' primary professional skills, practical abilities, and work experience as a nurse. It includes performing medical procedures in the treatment of patients with somatic diseases in healthcare institutions of a therapeutic profile.
Objectives / Tasks:	Objectives of the industrial practice include mastering the basic practical skills of a nurse in therapeutic departments of a clinical hospital.
Content of the Sections of the Educational Program	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Introduction to the hospital department -Thermometry -Medical documentation management -Physiotherapy -Rules for administering medications -Disinfection and types of cleaning -Acquisition of skills in patient care and dressing procedures -Providing care to patients with injuries -Resuscitation measures -Assistance to patients with nasal bleeding (epistaxis) -Rules for sterilization of needles and syringes -Final session. As a result of completing the industrial practice, the student should:	<p>Know and understand:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -indications, contraindications, and possible complications of using a rectal tube and urinary bladder catheterization; -safety procedures when working with biological materials; -risk factors for accidents in patients of different age groups (SLC-1); -main stages of a ward nurse's work; -requirements for personal hygiene and medical uniform of healthcare personnel; -levels of hand hygiene (PC-22); -risk factors in a nurse's work (physical, chemical, biological, psychological) and the principles of asepsis and antisepsis (PC-4). <p>Be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -perform anthropometry and thermometry, complete temperature charts; -measure pulse, respiratory rate, etc. (SLC-1); -provide care for the patient's nails, hair, and skin (PC-22); -carry out sanitary care of patients and provide assistance in cases of urinary and fecal incontinence (PC-4). <p>Have practical skills in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -nursing care for patients with diseases of various organs and systems; -care of critically ill and terminal patients (SLC-1); -basic methods of physical therapeutic impact on the patient's body (PC-22); -sanitary treatment of treatment and diagnostic rooms of a healthcare facility and practical patient care techniques (PC-4).

Types of Educational Activities:	Practical activity as a nurse assistant, performing basic nursing procedures under the supervision of a specialist, providing patient care, complying with sanitary and epidemiological regulations, and maintaining medical documentation.
Reporting / Assessment:	-Preparation and defense of the report: each student is required to submit to the university supervisor a practice diary, a summary report of the completed work, and a reference from the place of practice, signed by the institution supervisor and certified with an official seal. -Computer-based testing.
